UNION MOOSE HOLDING REDEDICATION CEREMONY FOR BLUE STAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY MARKER

During World War II, service flags were flown outside the homes of family members, placing a single blue star for each person serving in the military. The Blue Star Memorial Highway program began after the war by garden clubs in New Jersey whose members wanted to commemorate veterans of that war. The program has since expanded nationwide by the National Garden Clubs Inc., and statewide by the Federated Garden Clubs of Missouri, to pay tribute to all those serving or have served in the military. In Missouri, Routes 40, 50, 66, and 67 were the originally designated memorial routes; I-44, I-36, and I-70 have since been added to the list. There are currently more than 1,400 memorials in the state of Missouri, with new ones added each year.

A Blue Star Memorial marker was placed many years ago at the corner of Highway 50 and Koelling by the Union Garden Club. That location is now on the Southeast corner of the Moose Lodge grounds. The memorial had since shown its age over the years.

A project to refurbish the memorial, led by the Women of the Moose, brought the marker back to its original glory with efforts by Lodge and Chapter volunteers. A rededication ceremony is planned for Veterans Day, November 11 at 2:30 pm. Also in attendance will be members of the Missouri Garden Club, American Legion, V.F.W, and City and Franklin County officials. Following the ceremony, a reception will be held at the Lodge, and a BBQ that evening.

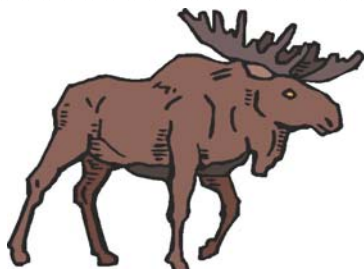

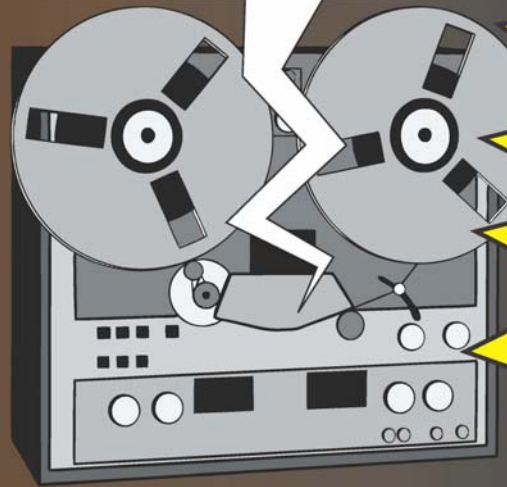
