LODGE DONATES FLIGHT 93 TIES TO AMERICAN LEGION POST 297 IN UNION

Community Service Chairman Larry Rutledge presented "Flight 93" ties to the 20 members of the Honor Guard at American Legion Post 297 in Union. The patriotic themed ties are decorated with a stars and stripes motif and a Moose emblem in the lower center. The Flight 93 tie sales contributes to the Flight 93 Memorial Project initiated by Moose International. This ongoing \$30 million fundraising project will contribute to the estimated \$58 million needed for the Flight 93 memorial, which is scheduled to open Sept. 11, 2011 for the 10-year anniversary of the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks on the U.S.

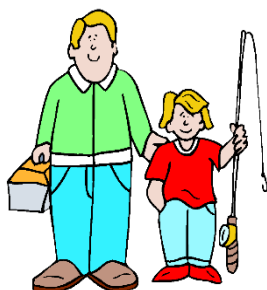
