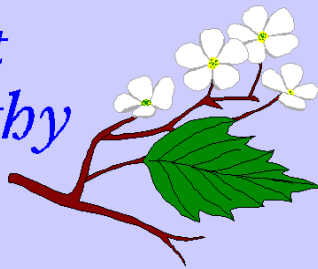

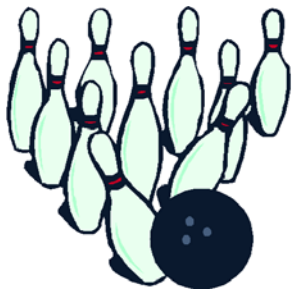

- must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (C+) or higher on a 4.0 scale

Applications must be returned to Moose International no later than June 30, 2008.

All qualified applicants will be placed in a random drawing to be held in the fall of 2008 at their Moose Association Annual Convention or at Moose International.

Winners will be notified by mail. Their scholarship check for \$1000.00 will be mailed directly to the college of their choice.
